RESOLUTION # 2011-7

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS of the Joint Fire Protection District Ferry County #3 and Stevens County #8 as follows:

1. That the county Assessors have notified the Commissioners of the Joint Fire Protection District that the assessed valuation of real properties lying within boundaries of said District for the calendar year **2012** is estimated at **\$128,162,786** (Ferry Co) + **\$52,709,357** (Stevens Co) = **\$180,872,143**.
2. That the attached hereto Exhibit A, "Ferry County Estimated Revenue and Expenditures" (by this reference made a part of this resolution) be and hereby is adopted as the budget of the Joint Fire Protection District Ferry #3 and Stevens #8 for the calendar year **2012**.
3. That the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Ferry and Stevens County, Washington, be and are hereby requested to make a levy for **2012** for said Ferry County Fire District #3 and Stevens County Fire District #8 of **\$36,000**.
4. That the County Treasurer of Ferry County, Washington, be and is hereby authorized and directed to deposit and sequester the monies received from the collection of the tax levy specified in Section 3 above in the amounts and funds specified below:
 - A. \$ 36,000 into the Expense Fund of said District
 - B. \$ _____ into the Reserve Fund of said District
 - C. \$ _____ Registered Warrant Fun
 - D. \$ _____ to be used for the sole purpose of paying the interest and principal of said District's General Obligation Bonds heretofore authorized and now outstanding. This levy to be without limitation as to rate or amount, and sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same shall become due.
 - E. \$ _____ into the other fund of said District
